Program Description

The Northeast Kansas Library System Staff and Executive Board enthusiastically announce a grant program exclusively for NEKLS school library members. **NEKLS will** offer up to \$50,000 in needs-based, competitive grants to school libraries that serve any combination of students aged K-12. All applicants must be <u>members</u> of Northeast Kansas Library System.

In recognition of the continued importance digital resources play in education, this year's grant program is designed to help school libraries obtain or maintain electronic resources for use by students and/or staff during the Fall 2021 semester.

The State Library of Kansas currently offers a rich array of electronic resources for all Kansas residents. Resources purchased using funds from this grant program must not duplicate state library resources.

Individual schools may apply for a lump-sum amount in grant funds, based on school population. A 10% school financial match is required, either through administration or donated funds. Several schools per district may be awarded grant funds. Consideration will be given to NEKLS member schools that have not received grant funds within the past five years, though all members are encouraged to apply.

Lump-sum grants will be awarded based on school population:

School enrollment (Spring 2020 semester)	Grant amount	Minimum matching amount
Up to 500 students	\$750	\$75
501 to 1500 students	\$1,500	\$150
1501 or more students	\$2,000	\$200

Preparing to Apply

- 1. Review this Application Instructions document thoroughly to ensure that you will be able to comply with all grant program deadlines and requirements.
- 2. Review the Questions on Application Form, which is included in as an appendix to this document, to ensure that you have all of the information you need to complete the application form.

Applicants' Steps in the Grant Program

See Timeline above for dates and deadlines.

- 1. Submit your application to NEKLS. Use the link in number 3, above.
- 2. NEKLS staff will notify you whether or not your application has been accepted.

For approved applicants:

- 3. Complete the online acceptance form. A submitted form indicated acceptance of grant funds and conditions by the school administrator.
- 4. Attend Grantee Information Session with NEKLS staff, online, or watch the recording.
- 5. Spend all funds by Friday, December 31st, 2021. **Funds unspent by this** date must be returned to NEKLS.
- Complete Financial and Narrative Reports as required NEKLS by Tuesday, January 11th, 2022. Late Financial and/or Narrative Reports may require a partial reimbursement of grant funds to NEKLS.

Evaluation Criteria for Grant Applications

Note that this grant program is competitive and needs-based. The selection committee will consider the following factors when evaluating grant applications:

- A. The entire application is thorough, concise, and clear.
- B. Support from school administration is indicated. (Question 10.)
- C. There is a demonstrated need for support to the library based on student/family population. (Questions 18-20.)
- D. There is a demonstrated need for support to the library based on the level of funding from the district and/or school budget(s). (Questions 22-26.)
- E. The application reflects the school's ability to provide a minimum 10% match and indicates source(s) of matching funds. (Questions 28, 29.)

- F. There is a clear purchasing plan. (Question 30.)
- G. The narrative section is persuasive, clear and concise. (Question 31.)
- H. The **school** has not received grant funding from NEKLS within the past five academic years. (Question 35.)
- I. The **district** has not received grant funding from NEKLS within the past five academic years. (Question 36.)
