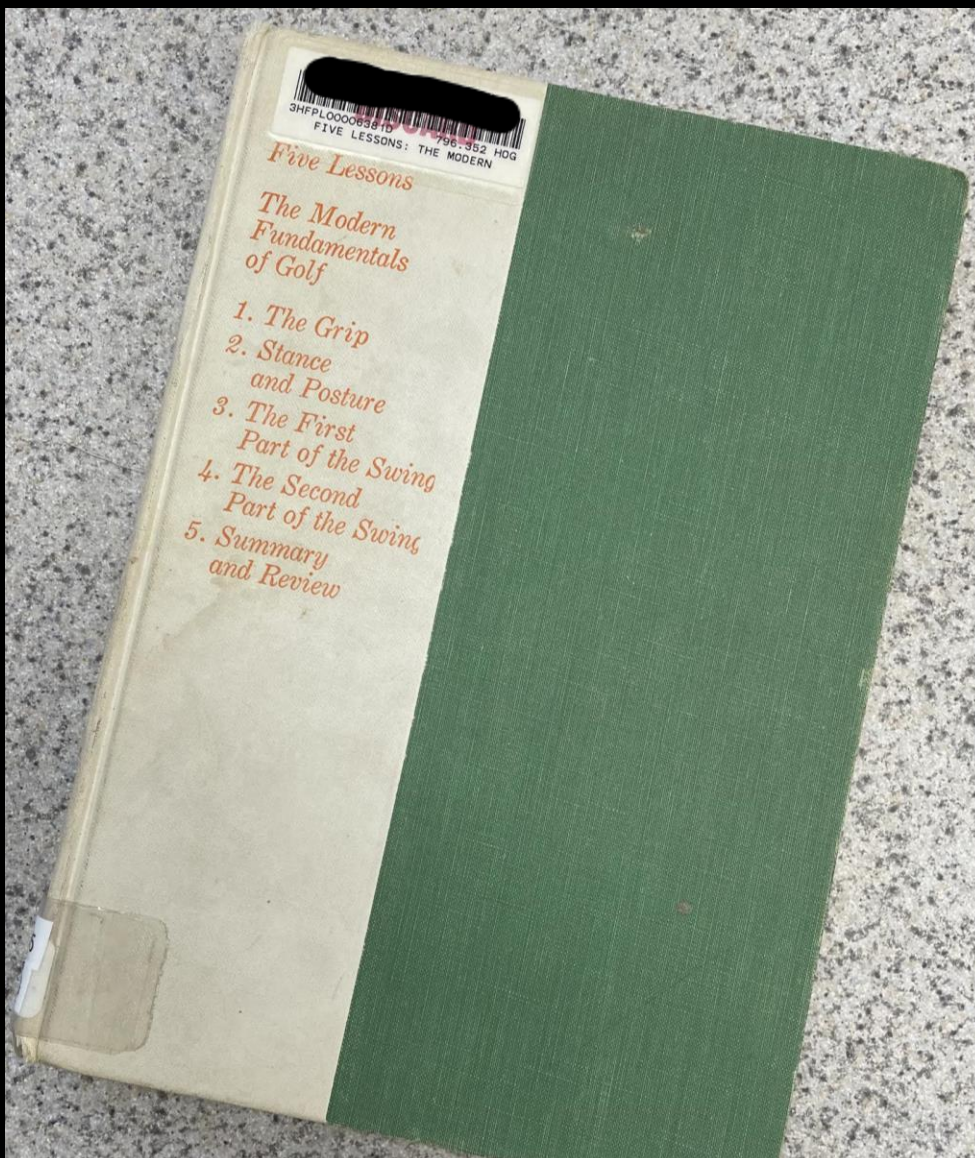
Fig. 10.7. Form: step 4.

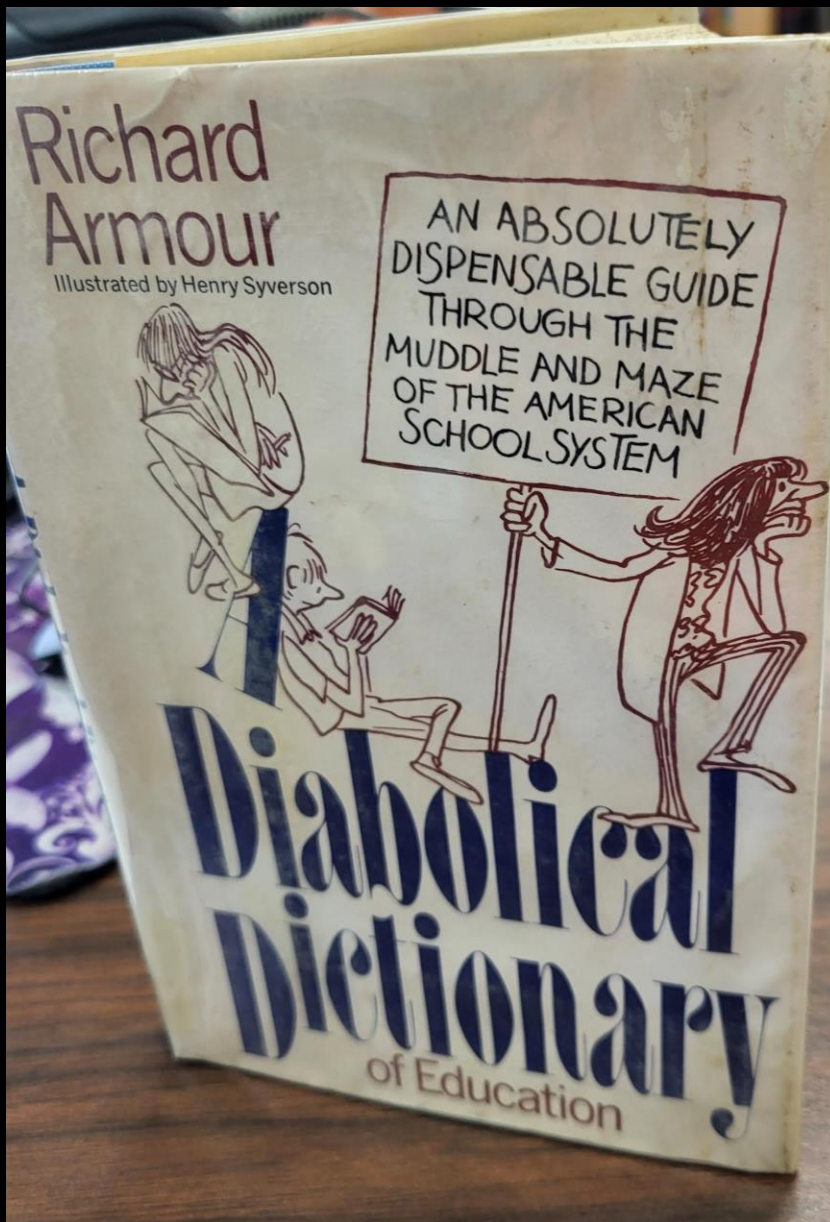
24 Crippling Blows

While the Quadrant Conference in Quebec had deferred a final decision on specific strategic operations in Southeast Asia, there had been no dispute over the Pacific. The Combined Chiefs of Staff had endorsed Admiral Nimitz's revised plan for launching the drive against the Japanese outer defense perimeter of islands by attacking the Gilberts, which were within range of American bombers in the Ellice Islands bases, before assaulting the more heavily defended Marshalls and Carolines, which were the conference, General MacArthur had also submitted his post-Cartwheel strategy, entitled "Reno II," for the capture of Rabaul early in 1944, to provide a naval base for amphibious operations north against the New Guinea coast and on up to the Philippines. He counted on having the full support of the Pacific Fleet, but Admiral King had other ideas.

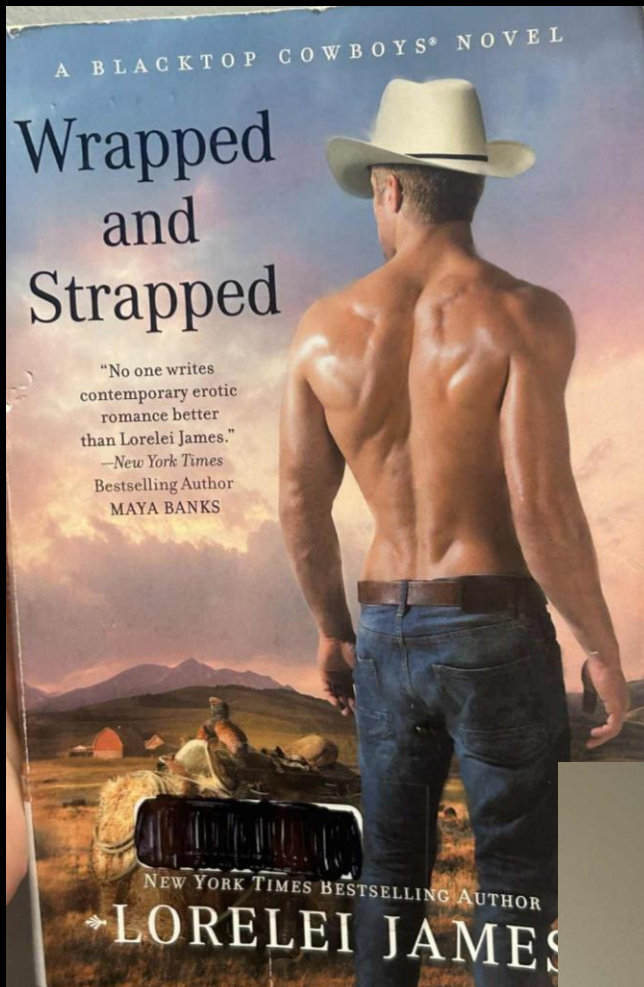
The conference at Quebec did not resolve the conflicts between the U.S. Army and Navy plans for a strategic advance on Japan. Significant while MacArthur had approval for his post-Cartwheel strategy in New Guinea, the Admiralties, and the Bismarcks, the Joint Chiefs had made mention of his proposal to invade Mindanao. Moreover, they specified "Rabaul is to be neutralized rather than captured," enshrining the passing strategy, and thereby depriving the South West Pacific Command of the naval base it needed to launch its invasion of the Philippines.

When he received the orders, MacArthur perceived them as a move by Admiral King to curtail his drive toward Manila in favor of the Navy's central Pacific thrust. His suspicions were not allayed by Marshall's equivocal assurance that no decision had yet been taken as to the next logical step for the SWPA Forces is the seizure of Mindanao. ever, it may be found practicable to make this effort through the The U.S. Army Chief indicated that a final decision would be made on the rate of progress of MacArthur's advance up the coast of New Guinea.
